When required, all other investigators will travel to the scene once the controlling command assigns the senior board member.

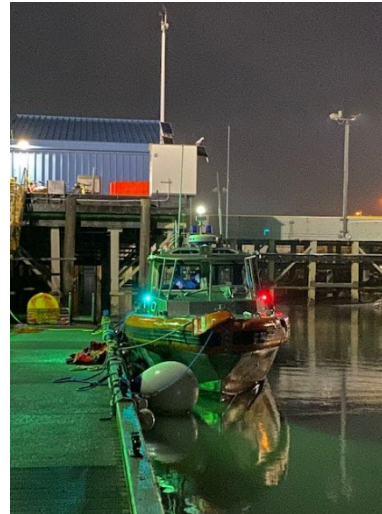

The Naval Safety Center's Investigation Directorate (Code 90) provides onsite and distance investigative support for Navy and Marine Corps mishaps covered under the OPNAV 3750.6 series and OPNAV/MCO 5102.1 series instructions.

From initial notification through salvage, investigation, and wreckage and evidence release, highly qualified and experienced Naval Safety Center investigators will guide you through the process. We maintain an extensive contact network of engineering and subject matter experts who can provide technical expertise during investigations.
