Educate.

Adults and children should know the basics: the sound of smoke alarms, the location of the nearest fire escape, and emergency phone numbers.

Invest.

Smoke alarms and fire extinguishers are essential in fire prevention. Have both in your home and office for protection.

Plan.

Families should have a plan ready that includes knowing whom to communicate with and where to meet in case of separation.

Inspect.

Regularly check if your smoke alarms, appliances, and outlets are in top condition.

Double check.

Switch off and unplug all cooking appliances and chargers when not in use. Don't keep fire hazards, such as paper towels and flammable liquids near burners.
