EMERGENCY?

Landslides and rockslides occur in every U.S. state and all over the world. They usually follow different weather or seismic events

Read more on how to protect yourself during a landslide:

- Plan what you will do and where you will go in the event of a landslide or rockslide
- Share the plan with your family and include your pets in the plan
- Sign up for alerts from the Emergency Alert System or the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration Weather Radio
- Text SHELTER + Zip code to 43362 (4FEMA) which will locate the nearest shelters in your area
- Listen for rushing water, mud or the sound of cracking trees or boulders. Look out for bulging ground water breaks in the ground or tilting stationary objects
- By the time debris flow is heading toward you, it may be too late to get away safely. Pay attention to warning signs beforehand and move to higher ground

Landslides can happen day or night. Staying away during a storm increases your chances of SURVIVAL
