

BONFIRE SAFETY



If you plan on having a bonfire learn safety guidelines and have a plan. Check with your local fire department for rules and regulations.

Keep children and pets at least 10 feet away from the fire to help prevent accidents and burns.

Never try to jump over the fire.

Never use accelerants like alcohol, gasoline or lighter fluid. Never burn anything with chemicals like aerosols, foam or paint as these items can release toxic fumes, explode or cause the fire to spread.

Never burn trash or discarded fireworks.

Check the weather before building any campfire or bonfire as high wind can cause the fire to spread quickly.

Never build a campfire or bonfire within 25 feet of any structure, building or anything that can burn.

Keep a bucket of water or a hose close by to help prevent the fire from spreading.
